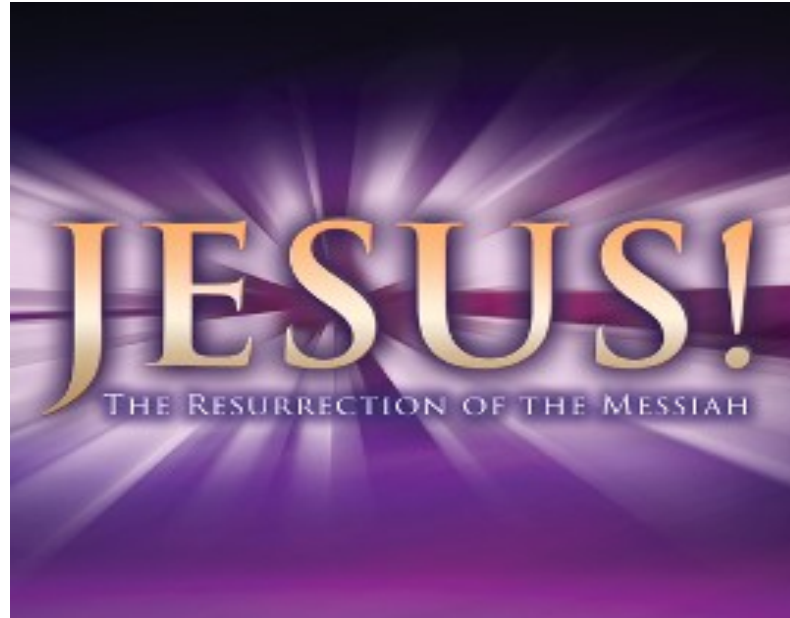

THE ANNIE ARMSTRONG EASTER OFFERING—Our church goal is \$8000; total collected: \$1446.00 to date.

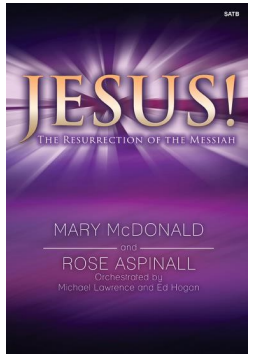

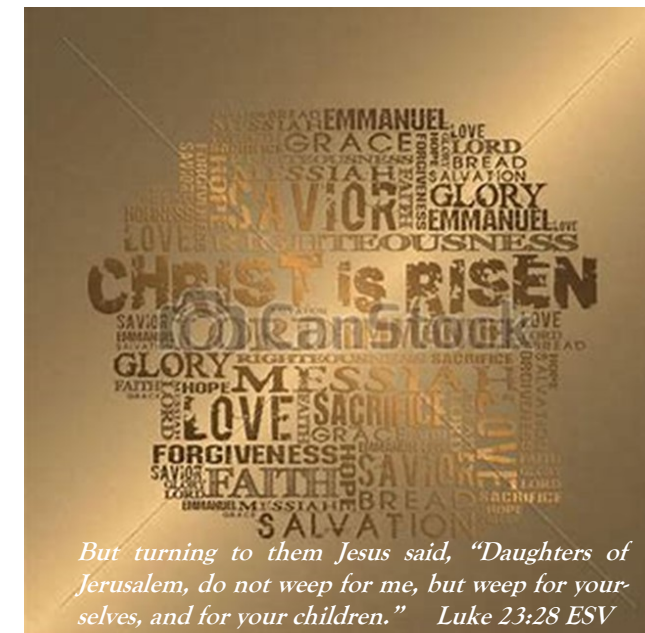
