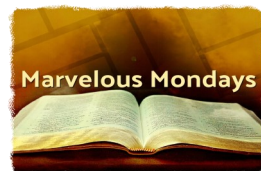
MINISTRY OPPORTUNITIES

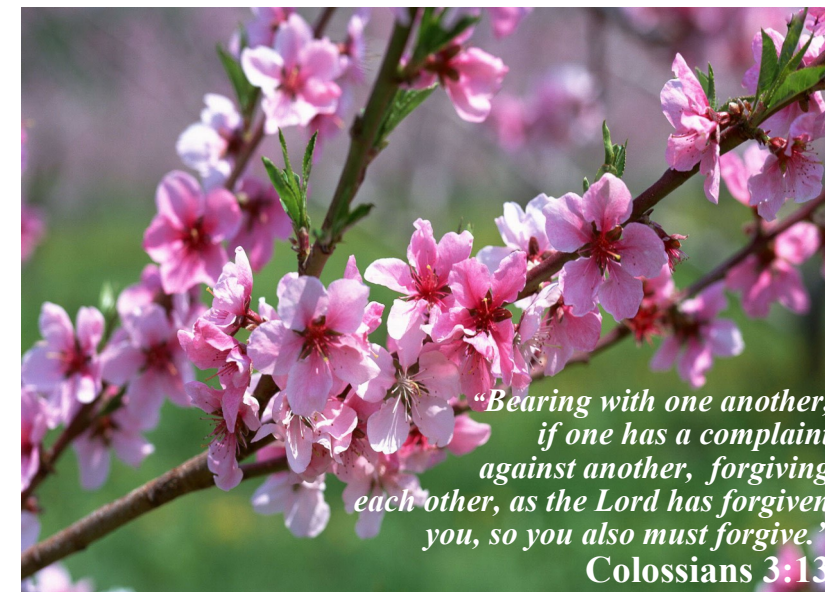
