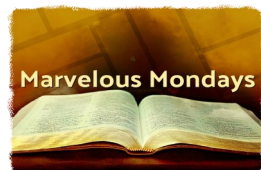
## MINISTRY OPPORTUNITIES

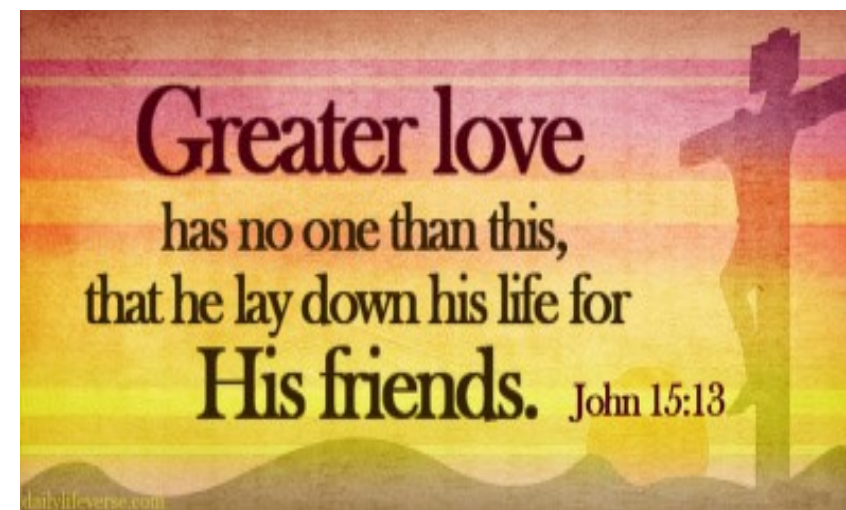
