# A Note From Harold



## Reading the New Testament in 2014

In Matthew 11:29 Jesus said, "Take my yoke upon you, and learn from me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls."

One of the things we can do as Christ-followers is make a decision to spend time in God's word. In our day we are blessed with multiple translations (KJV, ESV, NIV, NRSV, NAS, etc.) and various ways to access God's word (printed, audio and on electronic devices), yet the average Christian rarely reads more than a few passages a week outside of worship or a Bible study setting.

From what I can tell most people who don't spend time in God's word simply have not made it a priority. In 2014 I am challenging us as a church body to make a commitment to spend time in God's word on a regular basis. Rick has brought together excellent resources where we can read the New Testament together as a fellowship. In this plan we will have certain passages to be read each day with a mixture of days of reflection (where you can reflect what you have been reading or catch up when you miss a day or two). I believe this effort will aid greatly in your spiritual development as you spend time listening to God's word speak to you. Won't you consider how to set aside time in your day to listen to God?


#### RA Teachers
