Fabulous Four Fellowships (FAB4)

Would you like to get to know more people who attend our fellowship? Do you sometimes find yourself always talking to the same people at church but would like to get to know others? Then maybe Fabulous Four Fellowships (FAB4) is just for you. The way this works is as follows:

First, you'll want to express interest in your family or family group (singles can band together in groups of 2-4 for this ministry) taking part in FAB4 by letting us know of your interest in participating by Wednesday, August 26. Complete an interest card or call the church office to be added to the list.

Second, attend the informational meeting immediately (and briefly for about 10 minutes) after the morning service on Sunday, August 30 in the chapel where you will discover what four families (it's done by a random drawing of those interested participants) will be paired into a quad for the fall cycle of Fab4. You will also decide that day where the first fellowship of your FAB4 will be (it can be at your homes, at a restaurant, even in the park, it's completely up to the four family units involved to decide).

Third, at your first fellowship (in September) you will decide where your October fellowship will be if you haven't already done so. *There should be four fellowships among the four family units during the fall (one each month for September, October, November, and December).*


