

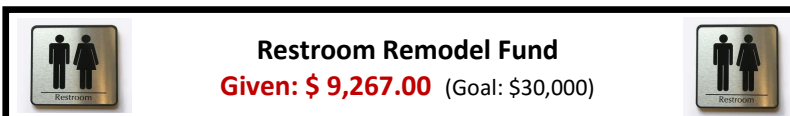
**MISSION NEW BOSTON**—This special event is on July 9-13. Sign up and get involved in helping out here in our town and community.
