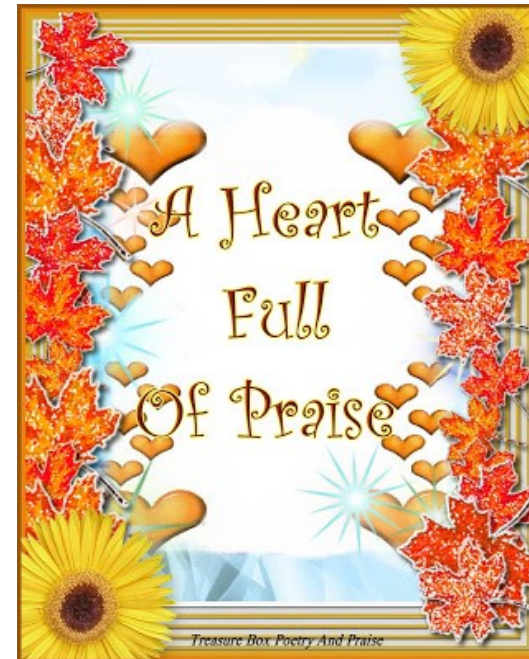


New Boston's FIRST BAPTIST CHURCH
