# DEACONS Following to Lead | Leading to Serve

# **QUALIFICATIONS FOR DEACONS**

The Bible Specifies the qualifications for Deacons in **1 Timothy 3:8-13.** The Jerusalem congregation was responsible for selecting men to serve in the key position of a Deacon. The same is true today.

<sup>48</sup> Deacons likewise must be dignified, not doubletongued, not addicted to much wine, not greedy for dishonest gain. <sup>9</sup> They must hold the mystery of the faith with a clear conscience. <sup>10</sup> And let them also be tested first, then let them serve as deacons if they prove themselves blameless. <sup>11</sup> Their wives likewise must be dignified, not slanderers, but sober minded, faithful in all things. <sup>12</sup> Let deacons each be the husband of one wife, managing their children and their own households well. <sup>13</sup> For those who serve well as deacons gain a good standing for themselves and also great confidence in the faith that is in Christ Jesus."
