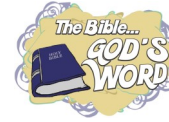

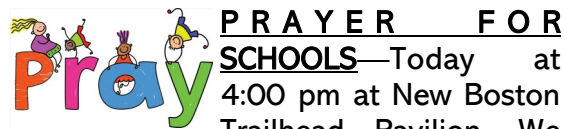
The altar will be open for public decisions, however you may still contact a staff member by cell phone if you feel more comfortable making a decision that way.
