CHILDREN'S HANDBELLS—Will not meet this Wednesday night. Handbells will resume Wednesday, November 1st at 4:45 pm.

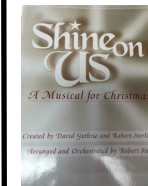
KIDS WORSHIP ARTS—Will not meet this Wednesday night. KWA will resume Wednesday, November 1 at 5:45 pm.
