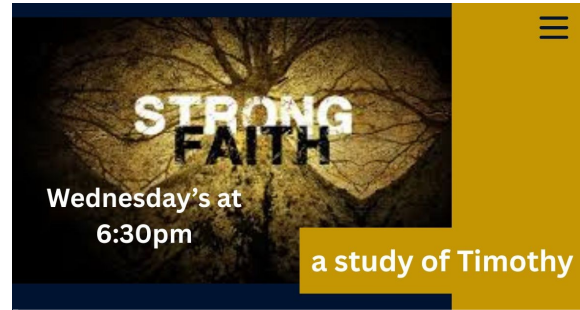

Offerings may be given by placing them in the offering box at the rear of the sanctuary before or after the service as well as in the offering plate.

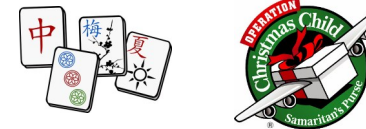
HOW TO BECOME PART OF THE FBC FAMILY
